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Background of Prompt Payment



Prompt Payment and Construction Lien Act

- February 2019 Service Alberta and Red Tape Reduction began consultation with industry stakeholders with respect to modernizing the *Builder's Lien Act* and incorporating prompt payment legislation.
- In August 2022, the *Prompt Payment and Construction Lien Act* was proclaimed with a twoyear transition period.



Why the Changes?

- Payment timelines had extended up to more than 70 days.
- Current lien process was timely and expensive.
- Lack of transparency in the payment process
- More jurisdictions were exploring the adoption of prompt payment legislation.

Prompt Payment Framework

- Mandated invoice timelines.
- Mandated invoice requirements.
- Mandated payment timelines.
- Adjudication as an additional dispute mechanism for non-payment





Impact to Infrastructure as Owners

- Clarity between owner and legislator
- System Changes
- Shift in invoice requirements
- Milestone payments/Performance based payments
- Enforced approval timeline





Impact to Infrastructure as Owners

- Selection of an adjudicator
- Timelines to gather information
- Confidentiality of adjudications
- Adjudication payments
- Transition to new rules and current contracts
